<p><u>English</u> Read every day and be able to answer questions about the text. Practise this term's spellings. Use the common exception words in your sentences. Write book reviews on the books you have read. Write a diary Write some questions for a significant person. Use Lexia regularly.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Practise your times tables out of sequence. Weight - look at weight on tins and packets; order them from heaviest to lightest. Bake some biscuits/cakes and weigh the ingredients. Recognise different coins and use them to make different amounts. Use Mathletics regularly.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Go on a walk looking for signs of Spring. List the different materials that are used to build your house and why. Look at how materials can be changed. E.g. bake a cake, make a model out of plasticine.</p>
<p><u>History</u> Use BBC Bitesize to research a significant monarch. Research George Stephenson and record some facts.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Identify some landmarks of the four countries of the UK. Draw a map of your route to school. Use Google maps to find different places you have visited.</p>	<p><u>PE</u> Challenge: How many star jumps/ hops etc can you do in one minute? Practise throwing and catching. Try to do some form of exercise every day.</p>
<p><u>Art/Design and Technology</u> Make a model of a train to celebrate the invention of the Locomotion. Draw a picture of something in the environment and shade it neatly. Make a healthy sandwich for Mr Grinling</p>	<p><u>MFL</u> <u>Spanish</u> Use BBC Bitesize to learn some new Spanish words and how to pronounce them correctly.</p>	<p><u>RE</u> Read the Easter story and think about why Easter is important to Christians.</p>
